Applications for the Internship Program are due no later then April 1, 2005. Applications postmarked later then April 1, 2005 will not be considered. Notification of acceptance will be mailed the week of May 1, 2005. At the time of notification you will be given an information packet and contract detailing the Festival and your responsibilities therein.

Your signed contract must be returned to us by June 1, 2005 or your spot will be forfeited.

Students accepted into the Internship Program must commit to remaining in the Berkshires July 1 to August 1, 2005.

Please Note: At this time the The Internship Program is unpaid and unaccredited. (If you can secure credit for this internship through your school, we are happy to support you, but this will be your own responsibility.) Housing and some meals will be provided by The Berkshire Fringe for the duration of the festival. All other expenses are the sole responsibility of the Intern.

Sorry, but at this time you must be 18 years of age to be eligible for the Intern Program.
